About the Position

We are seeking a **Field Safety Advisor** with strong safety leadership to join our construction team in Edmonton, AB. This position will visit various construction sites across Western Canada, and may be required to work extended hours including weekends when needed,

The key duties of this position include:

- Liaise with the HSE Manager and the Field Operations Manager to develop, refine, and implement Safe Work Policies, Procedures and Programs
- Perform incident investigations by assisting Site Foremen with investigations, finding root causes, and implementing corrective actions
- Mentor field foremen and field employees in their safety related responsibilities
- Perform site inspections/audits to identify corrective actions and preventative measures
- Develop and implement Job Safety Analysis (JSA) and Safe Work Procedures specific to the site
- Monitor and evaluate employees and sub-contractors for compliance with General Contractor Safety Requirements and Company Safety Policies and Procedures
- Provide in-house training for courses such as HLL/Rescue Kit Use/Fit-Test etc. as required
- Assist HSE Manager with the Field WCB Claims Management process

The ideal candidate will have:

- CSO or NSCO Designation required; CRSP Designation preferred
- Peer Auditor status preferred
- Sound working knowledge of construction processes and procedures required
- 5+ years' experience working in a field safety role
- Ironworker trade certification or previous ironworking/structural steel experience required; Experience with commercial and institutional projects preferred
- Excellent communication and strong interpersonal skills to properly relate to foremen, tradespersons, clients and subcontractors; Strong problem-solving skills
- Must possess a clear understanding of OHS Guidelines within all the Western Canadian jurisdictions
